Finishing the Creation/Decoration of Planters: This week plant seeds and soon bulbs.

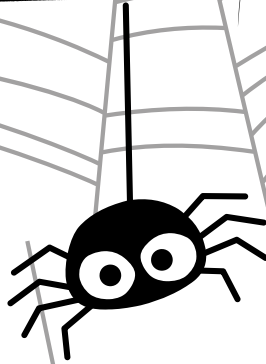

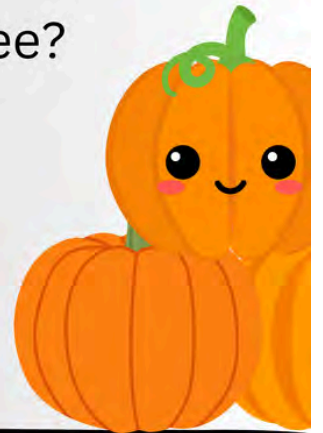
